The time in the **nursery or kindergarden** is near the end and the **start of school** gets closer. Therefore it is even more important to **prepare** children for school and to provide them with the **basics for their new stage of life**.

Latest during the last year in the nursery or kindergarden the **basic educational competences** like **colour recognition** and the **understanding of numbers, fine- and gross motor skills** as well as **social- and linguistic competences** should be trained.

The following game ideas can teach these **fields of knowledge** and **key competences**. Learning in a playful way provides fun and may also generate pleasant anticipation for the new life period.

Funny Animal Race (7788)
nurtures: understanding of numbers

Action Cube (4595)
nurtures: motor activity

Team-Painting (6127)
nurtures: social- and linguistic competences

Grap Game (7768)
nurtures: shape- and colour recognition

Funny Animal Race

On you mark, get set, GO! - This racy parlour game nurtures the **perception** and **social behaviour**. Children can train **counting** and also learn to win or even to lose a game. Once the racing frog takes position together with the nimble worm and the other animals at the starting area, excitement has no limits! The fascinating Action Cube!

This great cube made of solid timber is beating boredom and is even helpful. The action cube shows **12 different exercises**, in which you have **6 Yoga exercises** and **6 action exercises**. One exercise, for example, is the somersault. One example of the yoga exercises is the shoulder stand where the lower body is has to be stretched up standing on your shoulders. The players alternate. Lots of movements and fun will train the motor activity skills.

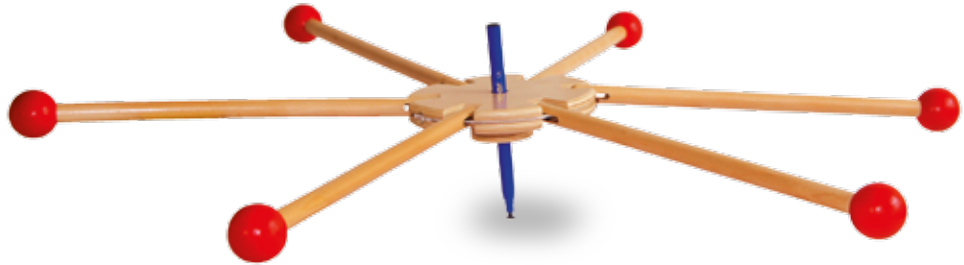
Game content:

Here **cooperation and communication** is in demand: Up to 6 painting arms will be hooked into the rubber band. A pen is placed into the centre of the game. Now try to paint a **picture** or write a **word or a sentence**. This trains the **concentration**, the **fine motor skills** and the patience of the individuals. A great educational toy made of plywood and massive timber.
